We held our Nebraska State Square Dance Festival on September 18 and 19 in Hastings, NE. Our featured callers were John and Deborah Jones from Arlington, TX; and our featured cuers were Ray and Virginia Walz from Green Valley, AZ. Both of these couples were featured the entire weekend and did a wonderful job. We also had many of our State callers & cuers performing in various halls, and many dancers danced to them, also. Our theme was "The Roaring 20's" which brought out a lot of amazing outfits for the weekend!

Our attendance was down some from last year, but those that were there said they had a really great time. We had 417 dancers in attendance, and 76 of those dancers came as "singles". They were all given "solo" ribbons to wear. There weren't a lot of people sitting out, as everyone wanted to enjoy the time they had to dance to these wonderful callers & cuers.

On Saturday morning at 9:30 a.m. we tried something new and decided to have a dance competition. People were given the rules when they came in Friday night in case they wanted to put a square together to compete the next morning. We thought only a few people would participate. However, we were pleasantly surprised when eight squares showed up to compete, and many more dancers crowded into the hall to watch. A judge (square dance caller) was assigned to watch each square compete. A square was allowed two warnings (yellow flags) if there was a mistake, and after that, if the square got the "red" flag, it was OUT. John Jones was the caller, and the dancing was Mainstream level. We practiced for a few minutes and then got started. It did not take long to get down to just one square. We didn't realize that Mainstream could be so tough. Since this was all done in just good FUN, the winning square was awarded LOLLIPOPS as their prize.

Next year our State Festival will again be in Hastings, NE, on September 17 and 18. The theme is "Dancin' in a Winter Wonderland." The featured caller will be Gary Shoemake from Tennessee, and the featured cuers will be Warren and Jeanne Shane from Kansas.

In existence for over 35 years, CALLERLAB has provided its members with licensing (to use copyrighted music), insurance, bimonthly newsletters, annual conventions, and an extensive variety of publications and training materials. What does this mean to us as square dancers? CALLERLAB has worked to develop universal dance programs and call definitions so that we are all taught to square dance the same way anywhere in the world. The mission of CALLERLAB is to promote, preserve and improve the activity of square dancing by recruiting and teaching new dancers and callers with standard curricula. It also works cooperatively with other organizations promoting recreational dancing.

In an era of diminishing numbers of dancers, it's good to have an organization working hard to reverse that trend with new ideas and a collective vision.
