2011 FESTIVAL CALLER AND CUER PROFILES

Trail-In Dance.....RANDY DOUGHERTY!

Randy comes from a Minnesota square dance family (which includes his sister, Dee Dee Dougherty). At age 15, the restriction imposed by a broken leg got him to try calling. While in high school and college he called dances throughout the Midwest. In 1979, he left his mathematics teaching position to devote full time to his calling career. Until 1986 he called on a regular basis for seven clubs in the Twin Cities area. At the same time he broadened his national and international calling exposure.

Randy now splits his winter calling time between Mesa, Arizona and the Rio Grande Valley in Texas; calling dances from ABC level through C3A. During the summer he calls at dances, festivals, and national conventions both in the U.S. and abroad. He has made many trips to Canada, Mexico, Sweden, Denmark, the Netherlands, Japan, Saudi Arabia, England, Germany, the Czech Republic, Australia, and New Zealand.

Randy thinks putting the 3 Fs back into square dancing "Fun, Family & Fellowship" will be the salvation for our activity. We look forward to having Randy as one of our callers for the HASSDA festival and the trail-in.

Festival Cuer...PATTI WHEELINGTON!

Patti first met Ray (Wheelington) at a set of square dance lessons he was teaching in 1986 and then dragged him into Round Dance lessons in 1987 to make sure he would learn to Waltz, Two Step, and Jive.
