There is going to be a line-up of some really great callers and cuers and we are looking forward to having a really good time. PLEASE NOTE: We are currently planning for the Festival to take place. However, due to the Covid-19 pandemic status we may have to cancel in the future based on local restrictions if things have not gotten better. We will be sure to post status of the Festival by June 1st, 2021 on both the HASSDA Website and the HASSDA Facebook page. With that being said, we have extended the pre-registration dead line date to June 30th, 2021 (rather than the June 15th that was printed on the flyer). With the uncertainty of the virus, we suggest you might want to hold off until after June 1st to pre-register.

Speaking of the HASSDA Festival, we are currently looking for host clubs or associations for future (2023 and beyond) festivals. This is a good way of fund raising for your group. Since we are a six state association, we would like to see some interest from some of the states where the festival has not been held in some time, such as Nebraska, Iowa and Arkansas. I would like to take this opportunity to introduce the callers of the two clubs that will be hosting our 2021 HASSDA Festival, as well as the Trail End dance on the Thursday night prior to the Festival. Please see their bio's below.



Chris Wildhagen (St. Joe Squares) Like many others I began

calling accidentally. I blame my brother for this mishap. Noel (My Bro) called one day “you all need to go to square dance lessons with us Tuesday night.” I had my doubts. Noel, Linda (my wife) and I danced with a kids club from the mid 50’s through the mid 60’s. 14 years later I felt a little rusty. “Aw come on, you’ll have fun,” so we went. And DANG, IT WAS FUN!

The caller teacher was a high school pal of Noel’s. And as a friend loaned Noel 2 45rpm square dance records to learn. One accident led to another when Noel brought the records to my house and asked me to return them to the caller on Tuesday night because he had to skip class that week. Curiosity is dangerous, I decided I would try (just for fun) to learn to call those songs. I learned them in about 2 days and returned them on Tuesday. The caller asked “did Noel learn these?” I said no, but I did. As a result I called both songs that night without a cue sheet. The caller didn’t say much, but handed me two more records to learn. Soon I was asked to call a tip at area dances. Area callers were generous and gave a newbie a chance to call a tip. If you did ok, they might ask you to do another tip at the next dance.

After teaching two mainstream and one plus class start to finish, I started a club in 1984 called the Crocodile Rockers (a plus club). The Crocs evolved into the St. Joe Squares and is still going today. Soon afterward, I was hired as the club caller for the Riverbend Promenaders of Atchison, KS.

Early on I started styling my music, changing choreography and imitating voices. I try to do about 15 different character voices from Elmer Fudd to Jimmy Durante. My (Hat Dances) where I change hats to fit characters has been used by clubs as a special or fund raiser.

Currently I am the club caller for St. Joe Squares, Maysville Wranglers in Maysville, MO, and Happy Times Squares in Lawrence, KS. I also call regularly for clubs in Iowa, Nebraska, and Kansas, as well as Missouri.

After 40 years of calling, teaching, dancing, and traveling, DANG, IT IS STILL FUN!

My goal is always to share that fun with the dancers.



Connie Graham (Maysville Wranglers) I started square dancing in 8th grade in our local 4-H club and really loved it, but life got busy and cheerleading and dating got in the way as well as my nine little brothers and sisters, so I forgot about it until the late 70's. My mom and dad were going to join the new square dance club in our town and wanted Eldon and I to take lessons, so we did and we were hooked! The calling of Lowell Willets, fascinated me; but, there weren't any women callers that I had heard of, so I never even considered it. We quit dancing in 1984 when we had our 4th child and then, once again, life got in the way.

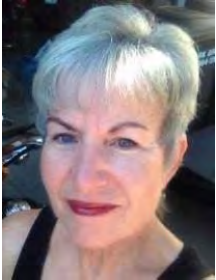
After we were empty nesters, we saw an ad for square dance lessons for the Maysville Wranglers with Larry Liebig as caller/instructor and we were on the way! We were hooked! We have been dancing again since 2006! Along with the square dancing, we also took up line dancing and country/western pattern dancing. We loved it all! I started to teach classes in line dancing in the area and have been doing that for about 10 plus years. I also did a lot of dance parties.

One day I received a call to do a party for the Northwest Missouri State University Alumni Association. Thought it would be fun and accepted the contract! A couple of weeks later, I found out that they wanted square dancing, not lines! Uh-oh! Too late to get someone else! I started to study. I know how to dance! I can do this for an hour or two! I can fake it! I ordered my first singing call and reworked it to use the very basic calls, circle, do-si-do, promenade etc. and we were off to the races. It was a total success. When we loaded my equipment in the car and headed for home, Eldon said, "you should really think about doing this!" I said, "really?" We talked to Chris Wildhagen to see if he would mentor me. He listened to me and decided to sponsor me and I have been having a ball ever since.

In 2014, I called at the Iowa State Convention and was contracted that very first day to call a club dance. Iowa has been good to me, I now call for five Iowa clubs regularly in addition to the dances that I call in Missouri. I have also called in Nebraska, Wisconsin and Ohio and every time I get behind the mic I love it more!

Thanks to Carl Boone I was able to attend the Callerlab convention in Albuquerque, NM. This was an eye opening experience that has given me valuable resources to enhance my calling skills.

Eldon (my husband) got sick with Guillain-Barre Syndrome in May of 2018 so I didn't call much for about a year, but got back on track when he got home and started to recover. The pandemic is of course taking its toll on us all, but we will get back to calling soon. I will call as long as my mind and body allow me to do it and as long as I'm having fun!

ATTENTION: SOLO DANCER LOOKING FOR A PARTNER.

How do you go about getting a partner at a dance? Here are some tips for dancing a lot more tips:

1. Get there early. Many dancers plan their whole night of tips at the beginning.
2. Don't be afraid to ask. You never know until you ask.
3. Display your SOLO and levels of dance proudly! Badges, ribbons, and the like that tell everyone you need a partner and what levels and positions you can dance.
4. Be a good dancer and a good listener. You're more likely to be asked again if you prove yourself on the dance floor. The best way to be a top-notch dancer is to dance as often as you can.
5. Don't be shy: just be friendly and introduce yourself
6. Remember to have a partner before you get on the dance floor – don't take a spot that a ready couple could have filled. Take this time to ask someone for the next tip!

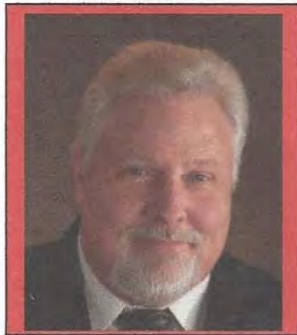
